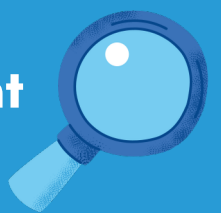
- Working on a variety of boat maintenance and upkeep such as rigging, mechanical work, painting, varnishing, electronics, winterizing and moving boats
